We have 2 facegroup pages you are welcome to join Avant Ballet Studio and Avant Ballet Studio-Concert photos. These groups provide lots of information and support/reminders to parents.

Please be aware that we are in an area that may be part of closure on catastrophic fire days. We try to give advance warning and also use our facegroup pages to let families know if we are affected.

To ensure the safe and efficient running of classes you cooperation with the following is appreciated.

1) Parents please organize for students to be picked up promptly at the end of each class

2) Parents please do not wait in the studio area, as students require the whole room to work in and are distracted by people waiting.

3) Please contact me (text, email) if your child will be absent from class so lesson plans can be adjusted.

4) Please write any messages in the 'day book' or email any information to me that we need to be aware of.

5) Please let me know if your address or phone number has changed to enable you to receive <u>all</u> information.

6) We now have a specific 'Medical action' form for students who have medical conditions that teachers need to be made aware of and where actions may need to be taken to assist the student. Copies can also be found on the website and from the teacher.

Students can do <u>unlimited</u> classes for a 'bundled' term fee! This represents excellent value on an already reasonable fee. (some specialized classes are not included in the unlimited bundle) Junior students (Level 1 –level5) fee will be \$462 Senior students (level 6 onwards) fee will be \$478

IMPORTANT REMINDER- All students eligible to study and perform pointe work must do a minimum of 2 ballet classes per week and a pointe class.

Regular private lessons for examination training, competitions or technique development are highly recommended for Level 1 and up. Schedules will be out soon. Private lessons are \$27 per half hour. Competition lessons also incur added fees and we have very limited spaces.

HOT PINK LEOTARD Students moving into Ballet 4, can wear a hot pink leotard as soon as they need one! Any style is fine and can be purchased from your preferred dance wear shop!

Cecchetti Ballet exams- Ballet students from 5 ½ years onwards may be eligible to participate in examinations. Please let us know if your child is interested. The teachers and I will also be sending invitations to the parents of students
we believe will be ready both technically and emotionally to participate.
We will be running additional exam only classes a couple of times per term for students who we believe will be ready to participate in the official
examinations.
Pre-Primary to Grade 1 students must attend class regularly once per week and additional exam only lessons.
Grade 2 onwards- students must attend a minimum of 2 classes per week and additional exam only classes.
We also encourage private/duo lessons – a couple per term for students
participating in exam from Grade 1 onwards
Grade Pre-primary to Grade 4 are examined in October/November.

Our current level 5 students (doing grade 4 examination will be in June)

<u>FEES</u> – Fees are based on a 9 week term and so students attending the full term will receive **bonus** weeks in some terms. Term 1 fees are due <u>FEBRUARY 24th</u> for continuing students and must be paid by this date to be eligible for the <u>discount</u>. New students please check the due date on your account. After this the full amount will be due (this year the discount date will be strictly adhered to). Please **contact me** or **leave a note in the "day book"** with the class teacher **before** the due date if you wish to make <u>part payments</u> or an <u>alternative due date</u>. Please forward your plan to me for approval.

Fees can be paid by **cash**, or **direct credit** through your bank and **credit card**.
